SPIRITUALITY

Sometimes I feel dissatisfied, restless, searching for more but I don't know what to do or what it means? Is God saying something to me in this? How do I know what God is wanting of me? How do I find this out?

PERSONAL GROWING

What are my values and beliefs that affect my personal choices in life? How do I cope with life experiences in light of my faith? How do I better understand myself and why I do the things I do?

*Each of us has a divine mission and purpose in our lives. Inherent to all of us is a desire to know, experience, and deepen our realization of this in relation to God. We want to know, **“who God is and how God is present and active in my live?”** and **“who am I and how do I enhance my life based on my own uniqueness?”***

***THE SUMMONS** faith formation process helps us to explore these questions and it helps us to understand what it means to be Catholic in our society and culture today.*

WHAT IS IT?

THE SUMMONS – is a formation process responding to the needs of adult Catholics in the Archdiocese of Winnipeg who desire to grow and understand our Catholic faith.

Sessions are held one weekend per month, Saturday and Sunday, for ten months, September to June each year in Neepawa.

Each weekend consists of a specific theme or topic of which the following formation components will focus on:



Theology – deepening our understanding of what the Church teaches and why ...



Scripture – discovering the treasure of God's Word speaking to us...



Spirituality – growing in my relationship with God and how God speaks to me and through me...



Personal Growth – focusing on the human aspects of everyday living and growing in self-understanding ...



Liturgy – how we express our faith through the celebration of the sacraments...



Ministry of Presence – in the second year of formation, a specific ministry is chosen by the participant to enrich our understanding of how God is present to us - in any situation and person.

FORMATION NOT INFORMATION

Adult formation does not just provide content and information, but it also engages the whole person – intellect, beliefs, values, and life experience – in a process and practice of Christian maturity. As adults we learn together from our sharing of life experiences. Formation fosters a sense of trust and community among the participants and encourages interactive sharing to enable us to grow and learn from one another in the context our Catholic faith.

WHO IS IT FOR?

This two year faith formation process is designed for ANY adult who desires to grow in our Catholic faith. It is also excellent Catholic formation for catechists, parish staff, and those involved in other parish and community ministries.

WHAT DOES IT COST?

THE SUMMONS is sponsored by the Archdiocese of Winnipeg through Sharing God's Gifts. **There is no registration fee at all.** Participants are required to purchase books which cost approximately \$50.
