Leader: Gracious God, may your love like water pour over our thirsty spirits, cleansing, refreshing, renewing us. Be present as we seek to know you, love you, and to respond to your unconditional love for us. We ask this in Jesus' name.

All: Amen.

Reader 1: Like deer that yearns for running streams, so my soul is yearning for you, my God. (Psalm 42: 1)

All: All who are thirsty come to the water.

Reader 2: My soul is thirsting for God, the living God. When can I enter to see the face of God? (Psalm 42: 2)

All: All who are thirsty come to the water.

Reader 3: Jesus said to her, "Everyone who drinks of this water will be thirsty again, but those who drink of the water I will give them will never be thirsty. The water that I will give will become in them a spring of water gushing up to eternal life." (John 4: 10)

Reflection:
What is your experience of thirst for God?
Pause

All: "If any are thirsty, let them come to me! Let them come and drink who believe in me!" (John 7: 38)
