Your kind prayers are requested for the repose of the soul of **Deacon Harold (Hal) Graham** who passed away on December 15, 2020 in St Albert, Alberta at the age of 87.

Deacon Hal was born on March 16, 1933 in Regina, Saskatchewan. Hal and his wife Eveline were married in 1955 and raised a family of six children. After a career with the Royal Canadian Air Force, Hal entered the Permanent Diaconate Program and was ordained a deacon by Cardinal George Flahiff on July 3, 1976.

Deacon Hal served at St Paul's High School, Winnipeg, as the Director of Marriage Preparation and Family Life at the Catholic Centre, at Our Lady of Perpetual Help Parish, Winnipeg and for many years at St Ignatius Parish in Winnipeg, until his retirement in 2008.

The Funeral Mass will be celebrated tomorrow, December 30, 2020, at St Albert Parish, St Albert, Alberta.
