Re.: Updated Protocol

We have received some questions about the number of people now permitted to gather indoors in Manitoba. All are reminded that the Archdiocesan protocols released on May 21, 2020 state that “as the number of people allowed to gather in our churches expands, these protocols will be adaptable.” This week the Government of Manitoba increased the number of people allowed to gather indoors from 25 to 50 effective Sunday, June 21, 2020. Therefore, when parishes are ready, and following the social distancing and sanitizing procedures outlined in our protocols, they can gather 50 people for celebrations.

The new provincial guidelines also allow for 100 people to gather outdoors
